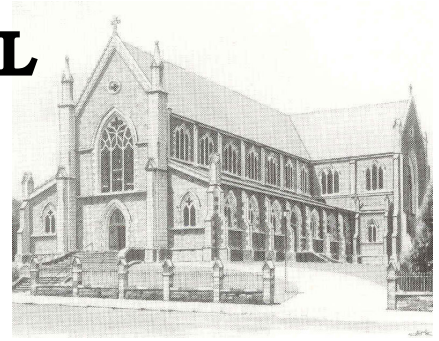

PhD RESEARCH AT ST PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL

My name is Regina Ryan and I am doing my PhD research on the Australian Catholic Church in the Diocese of Toowoomba, paying attention to the different leadership choices that are made in response to the decreasing availability of active clergy to meet the needs of parishes. Over the next twelve months I will be conducting anthropological field work in a number of parishes of the diocese, with permission to do so from Bishop Morris and each parish's Parish Pastoral Council. For the next four weeks you will see me around the parish, at services, meetings and events, participating in and observing the life of the parish and talking to parishioners. Later in the year, I will return for another four weeks, to continue this work and to interview those who agree to be interviewed, about their experiences in the parish and as a Catholic. I have been a parishioner of St Patrick's Cathedral for almost fifteen years and will happily answer any questions you may have. After Communion at each Mass this weekend Regina will introduce herself and her programme to the community.
