Fifth Sunday of Easter

28 April 2024

First reading: Acts 9:26-31 He explained how the Lord appeared to Saul on his journey.
Responsorial Psalm: I will praise you, Lord, in the assembly of your people.
Second Reading: 1 John 3:18-24 His commandments are these: that we believe and that we love one another.
Alleluia, alleluia! Live in me and let me live in you, says the Lord; my branches bear much fruit Alleluia!
Gospel: John 15:1-8 All who live in me, and I in them, bear much fruit.

INITIATION

Some people are all talk. And some days, I am one of those people.

In the scriptures today, John reminds us that "our love is not to be just words or mere talk". Our love cannot be just talk. This theme has been picked up by Nat King Cole and Frank Sinatra in the song *L.O.V.E.* (not reproduced due to copyright). But also, and with Mothers' Day just around the corner, in the song *M.O.T.H.E.R.* by Howard Johnson (1915):

- **M** Is for the Many things she gave me,
- **O** Means only that she's growing Old.
- **T** Is for the Tears she shed to save me,
- H Is for her Heart of purest gold.
- E Is for her Eyes with love light shining,
- **R** Means Right and Right she'll always be.

This shows an overlap between the word and the grounded actions which stand behind it. 'Mother' is certainly not an empty or actionless word here.

Attempting to apply this, I've pulled together two rough attempts at acrostic poems which touch on the themes of the scriptures this weekend and Christian life in general:

- **B** Bear the Good News
- **R** Receive the Word of God
- **A** Anticipate God's grace
- ${\bf N}$ Near the suffering and alone
- **C** Care for those on the margins
- H Host and guest of God's people
- **C** Christ-like in word and deed
- H Holy and pure
 - R Recognising of God's grace in the world
 - ${\bf I}$ Invitational and relational to/with God
 - ${\boldsymbol{S}}$ Steward creation
 - ${\bf T}$ Teach and preach the good news
 - I Instruct those who seek
 - **A** Acting with justice
 - ${\bf N}$ Never-forgetful of what Christ has done for us

Far from my best work, I will happily receive any other suggested base words. I would also delight in receiving any attempted poems based on your own experiences of love that is more than just words in Christian life.
