### 19<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

13<sup>th</sup> August, 2023

First reading: 1 Kings 19:9, 11-13. Go out and stand on the mountain before the Lord God. **Responsorial Psalm:** Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation. **Second Reading:** Romans 9:1-5 I would willingly be condemned if it could help my people. Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia alleluia! I hope in the Lord, I trust in his word. Alleluia! **Gospel:** Matthew 14:22-33 Command me to come to you over the water.

#### SCRIPTURE CHECK-IN - HOW IS YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE WORD?

When was the last time you were amazed by the scriptures? Or perhaps, there is something in the scriptures which intrigues you or baffles you. Or perhaps, again, I'm projecting my own relationship with the Bible.

I am certainly no scripture scholar, but have what I would (like to) describe as an amateur fascination in the scriptures. I do what I can to cultivate a warm curiosity for God's word. At the same time, I maintain something of a respectful caution lest I proof-text my own moral ideals by what I read and how I read it.

As a part of our work to bring about the parish vision according to the recently-launched strategic plan,

we are committed to the "Promotion of retreats, workshops and events being held in other cities". One such opportunity has recently been brought to our parish.

A parishioner has lately attended a 10-week course on Catholic foundations, run by Brisbane's Archdiocesan Centre for Catholic Formation. The second module of this course is on scripture. We are excited to be hosting a regional hub at the cathedral centre for a discounted price. Each Monday night from 21 August, we will be transported into the world of biblical scholarship and Church teaching on the scriptures.

I invite you to consider if this is an opportunity for you to renew your approach to God's word. Perhaps this is your chance to revitalise how you engage with the scriptures. Or perhaps, this is simply an opportunity to follow a sense of intrigue or interest.
