## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 16 July 2023

**First reading:** Isaiah 55:10-11 The rain makes the earth fruitful. **Responsorial Psalm:** The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest. **Second Reading:** Romans 8:18-23 All creation is waiting for the revelation of the children of God. **Gospel Acclamation:** Alleluia alleluia! The seed is the word of God, Christ is the sower; all who come to him will live for ever. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 13:1-23 A sower went out to sow.
