#### 19 March 2023 **Fourth Sunday of Lent**

## Change the Ending – Stop Domestic Violence

This is the strong message from the Red Rose Foundation. We were privileged to hear that message and surrounding issues of Domestic Violence recently when Betty Taylor, founder of the Red Rose Foundation was guest speaker at the St Saviour's College breakfast. Significantly this occurred at the celebration of International Women's Day. Betty is also a past student of the college. After the breakfast Betty kindly commissioned our St Pat's Red Bench which helps raise awareness of the plight of those families saddened by Domestic Violence.

The simple concept is the brainchild of the organisation's founder and managing director, Betty Taylor, who is delighted to see another bench pop up in her home town of Toowoomba. The bench is the first in a Catholic Church in Australia and bears the simple message. Change the Ending: Stop Domestic Violence.

"So often we see injury and death from domestic violence that is predictable and preventable. Our foundation works in a range of ways to directly support women and to advocate for law reform but at the grassroots level, we want to educate the community to speak up and have conversations about how we can all play a role in calling out behaviour that doesn't honour every individual's human dignity. The red benches are an awareness tool for such conversations," Ms Taylor said.

Some facts about *Domestic* Violence and Australian women:

- 1 in 3 women have experience physical violence, since the age of 15 years;
- 1 in 5 women have experienced sexual violence;
- 1 in 4 women have experienced emotional abuse;
- Women are 5 times more likely than men to experience violence from an intimate partner:
- Of those women who experience violence, more than half have children in their care.
