# "MAY GOD, WHO HAS BEGUN THIS GOOD WORK IN YOU, BRING IT TO COMPLETION"

There is one priest and one priesthood. A year ago, on 25 June, Bishop Robert ordained Fr Brian Redondo and me as presbyters of this priesthood.

For our pre-ordination retreat, Bishop Greg of Lismore explained how it is the love of God and the way God sees us which changes (us) at ordination. The same thing is true for each of the sacraments. He created the world out of love, made each of us in the same love, loves us in all things; and He loves us into priesthood. This image and explanation really struck me, and I have reflected on it a lot this past year.

Celebrating Eucharist has become a significant part of my life. Somewhere in the region of four hundred Masses in the last year, I am yet a novice. It is an honour and honestly a strange experience to preside at the Eucharist; certainly it is an experience of self-emptying. The love of God is manifest and made present. One prayer which captures this and never gets old for me is the prayer said by the presider just before receiving Communion:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God,

who by the will of the Father and the work of the Holy Spirit,

through your death gave life to the world;

free me by this your most holy Body and Blood

from all my sins and from every evil;

keep me always faithful to your commandments,

and never let me be parted from you.

God's mercy has been a prevailing theme of the year. This is not confined to

celebrating the sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession), though I have spent scores of hours in the confessional. It has also included the works of Mercy, Eucharist, and accompaniment of people in all walks of life throughout the parish. Significantly, it has also featured in coming to

understand my own brokenness and need for God's mercy.

Christ the Good Shepherd (Pastor Bonus), whose image featured on my ordination card [pictured], has been my guide. He has led me through all kinds of valleys and over mountains. Again and again, He has led me to the cross.

My thanks go out to Emeritus Bishop Robert, Fr Michael, and the staff of the parishes who have helped me start to settle into the presbyterate. Many thanks also to my friends, family, and brother priests who supported me to the day of my ordination and throughout the last year. And finally, thank you to each and every parishioner and visitor - all those who I have encountered through ministry at St Thomas More's and St Pat's Cathedral Parish. Thank you for being the face of God;
