## FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT 27 November 2022

First Reading: Isaiah 2: 1-5 The Lord will gather all nations in eternal peace in the kingdom of God.

Responsorial Psalm: Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

**Second Reading:** Romans 13: 11-14 The time has come, our salvation is near. Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Lord, show us your mercy and love,

and grant us your salvation. Alleluia!

**Gospel:** Matthew 24: 37-44 Stay awake, you must be ready.

Feeling grateful and not letting others to know about it is as good as not feeling at all. I remain grateful for all your love and support shown through your appreciation of what I have to offer in term of my ministry and correction when it was needed. Each and every one of you have contributed to what I am today. As I move forward to St. George, I look at the future with hope and my past with gratitude, knowing well the good Lord is with me and will continue to bless me and through me many others. Recently we sold the family house in Roma. For myself, and my siblings it was sad to let go of the place we have all spent many of our years growing up – for me almost all my young life, as we moved there when I was 4. We knew every nook and cranny of the house and yard as we played and studied and partied over those years. So it causes some sadness to say goodbye to that part of our history. But at the end of the day it is only a building – what made it a home was our parent's love, our shared family experience and the place of growth, wisdom and being safe from the world when needed.

Todays gospel inviting us to STAY AWAKE! incites in me more than getting ready for the end times, when the Lord will come. Like Noah it is about listening to the reality of life, listening to the depth and true meaning of what is happening in our lives. We are often fed social media and information in general that appears to be the complete story but often isn't. We are not invited into the depth of what is really happening. Some call this a "dumbing down" of our lives. We don't look deeper. We fail to look for the true meaning and understand what is really happening and why.

As a family when Mum and Dad passed away our need to gather at the house in Roma also dissipated. Without Mum and Dad the home returned to being just a house. When we reflected on this as a family we realised that the gift of a home doesn't require a physical place. We gather using Whatsapp online to share news and views etc. Each year we gather somewhere for the weekend – no mean feat with 8 of us, plus spouses. This becomes our home – our place to share love, support, concern, joy and some tears.

When Mum and Dad passed away we could have sold the house and finalised things and gone about our lives catching up with each other in an ad hoc way. But we STAYED AWAKE! to what was important and decided to build a different "home".

So as you begin your Advent journey I invite you to reflect on what is the deeper meanings in your life that you need to STAY AWAKE! to, and take notice of. Then you will be AWAKE! in time, to celebrate a Christmas where you can see the true *Emmanuel* – a God who is always with us.
