A word from our new assistant Priest ...

G'day, everyone! My name is Brian Redondo. I was born and bred in the Philippines, and before I entered the seminary, I worked as a nurse. Quite a change, right?

My journey to the Diocese of Toowoomba began in June 2019 when the benevolent and imperturbable Bishop Robert McGuckin invited me. I spent two months at St. Mary's Parish in Warwick, getting to know the area and its lovely people. I must say, it felt like a grand adventure for an outsider like me! I owe a huge thanks to Fr. Terry Hickling for taking the time and making the great effort to drive me around the diocese. And Franco Filipetto, the parish priest, was an absolute delight. After two months, I went back to the Philippines to finish my theological studies in Manila.

Like General Douglas MacArthur famously said, "I shall return," and return I did in 2020. Unfortunately, it was right before the COVID lockdown, and Australia had closed its borders. But fate had other plans for me. I joined the Holy Spirit Seminary in Brisbane to immerse myself in Australian culture, learn Aussie English, and meet other seminarians who were discerning their path to priesthood in Queensland. I consider myself lucky and grateful for this opportunity, and I'm still learning every day.

After spending a year at Banyo Seminary, I moved to Cambooya Parish. There, I lived by myself on placement, assisting the Greenmount, Clifton, and Leyburn Parishes. It was a wonderful experience, and I couldn't have done it without the guidance of Fr. Rod MacGuinley, the parish priest at the time.

On the feast day of St. Joseph in 2021, I was ordained as a deacon at St. Mary's Church in Warwick. Then, I had the pleasure of serving in Stanthorpe Parish alongside Fr. Gonzalo Duran, the parish priest. Later, I returned to Clifton Parish, where Fr. Nathan Webb and I were ordained as priests on the 25th of June 2022 in St Pat's Cathedral. It was an incredible moment of joy and gratitude.

And just recently, on the 10th of July 2023 (the day before the installation of Bishop Ken Howell), Bishop Robert handed

me an appointment letter stating that I would be moving to St. Pat's Cathedral. So here I am, like in Psalm 40, saying, "Here am I, Lord. I come to do your will." I'm truly grateful for the warm hospitality of Fr. Michael O'Brien, the Dean of the Cathedral, and Fr. Nathan Webb, as well as the whole Cathedral team.

I hope to be able to share and contribute to our local church in meaningful ways.

Being a priest for over a year now, I am thankful to the Lord for guiding me every step of the way. I have become accustomed to celebrating Mass with two, four, or even smaller congregations. So, moving to a bigger church like St. Pat's Cathedral will be quite the change for me. But change is good, right?

I look forward to meeting all of you soon. Until then, may God bless you abundantly and remember to take it easy! Hooroo!
