Plenary Council 2022 – Final Session

The final session of the Plenary Council has come a conclusion. The voting, both Deliberative (clergy) and Consultative is completed. These decrees are now sent to the Vatican for approval before being promulgated here in Australia for the church to be formed and guided by their wisdom in the coming years. Following is each decree and a short summary of the content, not including all points due to space:

Reconciliation: Healing Wounds, Receiving Gifts.

- We will strive to develop a cross cultural understanding within all clergy, religious, lay-workers and volunteers;
- Say sorry for all harm the church has incurred on any Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples;
- Endorse the "Uluru Statement from the Heart" and encourage engagement in its ideals.

Choosing Repentance – Seeking Healing.

- Say sorry to all victims and survivors of abuse, their families and communities;
- Recommit to the church responding with justice and compassion to those who have suffered abuse;
- Encourage local memorials to those who have been affected by abuse;
- Foster environments of safety and safe practices;
- Study and address the systemic failures to keep children and adults at risk, safe.

Called by Christ – Sent Forth as Missionary Disciples.

- Develop resources, formation and education programs to respond to the needs of our socity;
- Develop a greater culture of inclusion;
- Parish Councils to establish opportunities to listen to people on the peripheries;
- Develop a long term plan to evangelise the community;
- Better support for dialogue within the community around marriage, sexuality, family.

Witnessing to the Equal Dignity of Woman and Men.

- Through formal policies and intentional practice, the experiences and perspectives of women, including women who exercise ministry, are heard, considered and valued at every level of church;
- That women are appropriately represented in decision-making structures of the church;
- Should the universal church be modified to authorise the diaconate for women, the Australian church works to implement this change wholeheartedly;

Communion in Grace: Sacrament to the World.

- Promote the fullest participation in the liturgy as possible;
- Promote the rich heritage of the Eastern churches;
- For the Bishops Commission for Liturgy to seek a new English Translation of the Mass;
- Seek the expanded use of the Third Rite of Reconciliation where appropriate.

- The diversity of the Catholic community more explicitly recognised;
- Open greater opportunities for formation and ongoing study.
- At the Service of Communion, Participation, and Mission: Governance.
- That Synodality be the style of leadership Encounter, Listening and Discerning;
- Undertake a Diocesan Synod every 10 years.

Integral Ecology and Conversion for the Sake of our Common Home.

- Recognise the sacredness of the earth and undertake more ardently to protect it;
- To endeavor to defend the human life from conception to a natural death, especially those most vulnerable.
