SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT 4 December 2022

First Reading: Isaiah 11: 1-10 He judges the poor with justice. **Responsorial Psalm:** Justice shall flourish in his time, and fullness of peace for ever.

Second Reading: Romans 15: 4-9 Christ, the hope of all people. **Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Prepare the way of the Lord, mke straight his paths:**

all people shall see the salvation of God. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 3: 1-12 Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.

Seeing and Hearing through Advent

"*Look and listen*!" these words echo in my mind's ear from childhood and moments of parental guidance. What I've come to realise, over time, is that these are not just words meant to draw the attention and elicit response from children but words of advice for anyone attempting to live a life with God.

They are echoed in St John the Baptist's words which we hear in every Mass at Consecration - "*Behold*..." which might as well be "*Look*..." or "*See here*..."

Then, the monastic *Rule of Saint Benedict* (c. 500) opens with the word "*Listen*!" in the imperative (commanding) form. This mirrors the ancient Israelite *Shema* ("*Hear/Listen*") prayer: "*Hear*, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise." (Deut 6:4–9 NRSV; *c.f.* Deut 11:13–21; & Num 15:37–41).

With this in mind, John the Baptist stands out as a great prophet indeed. Not only because he proclaimed the coming of Christ because he allowed and encouraged us to see and hear, to *look and listen* for the way that grace is moving in the world around us.

So, this strange desert character, John the Baptist, who we see feature in today's gospel account, is more than a guide to singers (for whom he is a patron) and parents; he is the ultimate guide for all of us in preparation for the coming of Christ. There is none better than Our Lord's own cousin to know what it means to speak in the words of Christ and live in relationship with Him as His brothers and sisters. Following his guidance and example, we can grow in recognition of grace already at work as we prepare the way of the Lord.

This week, I encourage you to *look and listen* not to the distant approaching jingle of bells but to what is right in front of you and right under your nose.
