First Reading: Wisdom 9:13-18 Who can comprehend the will of God?

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 89:3-6 In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge.


Second Reading: Philemon 9-10 Receive him, not as a slave anymore, but as a very dear brother.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia! Let your face shine on your servant, and teach me your laws. Alleluia! Gospel: Luke 14:1,7-14 All who exalt themselves shall be humbled and all who humble themselves shall be exalted.

One of the areas the Grounds Committee has been working on and giving much consideration to, is a practical space for gathering in the grounds of St Pat's. As you know when we have a morning tea or other gathering it has to be in the entrance area on the Neil Street side of the Cathedral.

It would be good to have an alternative area that is designed for that purpose. We would like to propose to the Bishop the possibility of constructing an arbour similar to that at Laurel Bank Park (below). Whilst it will naturally take years to get it to the same standard it would be a great place to gather, not only for morning teas, but for those waiting for a baptism, wedding or funeral. Also just a quiet place for reflection. In preparation for putting the proposal before the Bishop we would hope to show that there is considerable parish support for such a project. The cost is substantial, given the value of steel at the moment – estimated at \$50,000, hence needing the Bishop to approve the outlay. The measurements would be 18 metres length, 5 metres across and 3 metres high. This allows plenty of room for a good number of people to gather comfortably. It would become a beautiful place within our grounds and enhance the space.





We invite you to have a think about this project over the coming week.

Next weekend we simply request a YES/NO to the following question – Do you believe that the addition of an arbour at St Patrick's will enhance the beauty of the grounds and be of practical use to St Patrick's Parish Community?

We would hope to encourage the purchase of monogrammed bricks to create the floor within the arbour, at a later stage of the project.
