Living with the Joy of Easter

Today, and over the coming weeks we hear stories of the disciples grappling with coming to terms with the message of the life and death and life of Christ and how to live that out in a divided world. Our thoughts move to a similar experience after the uplifting and thoughtful journey of Lent and Easter. It is now that our minds move toward the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and to consider how we might welcome the direction that that same Spirit may lead us today. One of the ways of living in the Spirit is to make yourself available for the service of our parish community. This maybe being available for one of the ministries - reading, Eucharist, welcomer and so on. Another is to nominate for the Parish Council. When I joined the parish last year it was time for 3 parish council members to be replaced, however they kindly remained to help me settle into the parish. I thank them for their generous gift of time and commitment, it has been much appreciated. It is now time though for you to be considering the possibility of being part of the parish through membership of the parish council.

Parish Councils are a representative body from within the community that share the feelings, thoughts and actions of the whole community. In a real sense they are the voice of the community to assist in identifying the needs and also the joys of the life of our community. They are one of the important ways in which the priests in a parish work closely with the people to set direction and focus for our community. Last year Bishop Robert launched the Diocesan Pastoral Plan to offer as a guide to each parish in helping to be aware of the areas that should be a focus within the life of the community. This plan is of assistance to our council's deliberations and we look at the local interpretation of "Family Engagement, Spiritual Development, Parish Leadership, Liturgy, Creating a Safe and Welcoming Church, Social Justice", and we add, Ecumenical endeavours!

The first step in the process for membership of the Parish Council is to recommend a name. Attached to the bulletin this week is a Recommendation Form. It is an invitation to take a moment to think of people you believe would be an asset on the Council. It is not necessary to ask the person whether they wish to be recommended, as the current members of the Parish Council will approach them at a later time. You may like to recommend yourself for membership. The completed recommendation forms can be placed in the boxes located on the tables, handed to the priest/current council member, returned to the Parish Office or posted. Once these recommended people have been approached if they accept, they become nominees and depending on the number of nominees there will be a time of discernment and if necessary a parish vote to help decide. At each stage the parish community will be part of the process. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to speak with any of the priests or the current Parish Council members - Paul Howard, Basil Dass, Freda Coorey, Andrea Braithwaite, Roberta Cooke, Peter and Julie Ramsey and Sam Ginardi. Please give this some serious consideration for the benefit of our Parish Community.
