## SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD - Sunday 16 April, 2022

First Reading: Acts 10:34, 37-43 We have eaten and drunk with him after his resurrection from the dead.

Responsorial Psalm: This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4 Look for the things that are in heaven, where Christ is.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Christ had become our paschal sacrifice;

let us feast with joy in the Lord. Alleluia!

**Gospel:** John 20:1-9 The teaching of scripture is that he must rise from the dead.

## The Easter Struggle for Justice

"They killed him by hanging him on a tree, yet three days afterwards God raised him to life and allowed him to be seen" (Acts 10:39-40).

Death has lost its power; even its causes such as torturing, scourging and bullying have lost their power. Thus, the resurrection is not a myth or fiction, it is real.

My faith experience in *this* Easter is about the people of Sri Lanka. A tyrant came to power as an executive president frightening the minorities using hate speech, employing underworld acts. Now, the whole country is undergoing an economic and political crisis. He uses nepotism to steal people's money. Therefore people do not believe his government and its fake news. Today people are in their power of love and calling for justice. It's a glimpse of the resurrection of Christ "by getting rid of all the old yeast of evil and wickedness, having only the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth" (Corinthians 5:8). We have seen in the capital city of Colombo, Christians, Buddhists, Muslims and Hindus coming together to share a meal as they march forward to overcome a dark future (photo above).
