The community of St Patrick's Cathedral Toowoomba is committed to the implementation of the Toowoomba Diocese Safeguarding Policy through its related procedures and practices. This revised and updated policy prescribes contemporary best practice to enable the prevention of harm to, and protection of children, young people and vulnerable adults. Our efforts in safeguarding children, young people and adults at risk are guided and measured by the ten National Catholic Safeguarding Standards (May 2019) based on the ten Child Safe Standards developed by the Royal Commission into Child Sexual Abuse (Final Report, December 2017). These Catholic Safeguarding Standards are aligned with the Australian Government's National Principles for Child Safe Organisations based on the work of the Royal Commission. National Catholic Safeguarding **Standards** provide a framework for Catholic Church entities to build child-safe cultures through:

Training, implementation of this policy, monitoring and regular auditing for compliance is ongoing work for all members of the Diocesan Safeguarding Ministry. In recent months clergy, employees and volunteers in diocesan and parish ministries have taken part in safeguarding training and education provided by the Diocesan Safeguarding Ministry and/or the Parish.

A revised Toowoomba Diocese Safeguarding Code of Conduct (22 March 2021) has been developed, discussed and shared with the members of the various Parish ministries and employees. This Code of Conduct names and affirms standards of respectful and responsible behaviour expected of all personnel and volunteers in their relationships with children, young people and adults at risk. In our efforts to create an environment that is welcoming, culturally safe and inclusive; I encourage all members of our community to take the time to read (and if required as an employee or member of ministry sign) this document as a means of showing an understanding that the whole community is responsible for the safeguarding of children, young people and adults at risks in our midst. To ensure that all members of the parish community have access to the policies referred to in this bulletin and resources to assist in developing an understanding of safeguarding procedures and practices (including reporting responsibilities); in the following weeks a Resource Page will be added to the website to provide further information.
